

CIRCULAR LETTER No. 009/LC/PR/MINMAP/CAB/CT2 of 07 SEPT 2017 Relating to the execution of road maintenance works by Councils through direct labour, with regards to credit votes allocated within the framework of decentralisation for the 2017 financial year.

Within the framework of the execution of the Public Investment Budget (PIB) for the 2017 financial year, and in accordance with the provisions of Decree No. 2010/0240/PM of 26 February 2010 to lay down the modalities for exercising some powers transferred by the State to Councils, credit votes were allocated to Councils by the Ministry of Public Works and Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development for council roads maintenance works.

So, in order to enable the maximum consumption of the credit votes and continuous improvement of results on one hand, and make up for the execution of the projects involved which are already lagging far behind schedule, on the other hand.

I hereby notify you, exceptionally, the authorisation to execute works related thereto by direct labour, in accordance with the provisions of point 675 of Circular No. 001/C/MINFI of 28 December 2016 instituting instructions relating to the Execution of the Budget of the State, Administrative Public Establishments, Regional and Local Authorities, Subsidized Organisations for the 2017 financial year.

However, in view of ensuring a better local physical and financial management of the execution of works by Divisional Delegations of the Ministry of Public Contracts, the implementation of the authorisation thus given to you, shall be subject to the imperative respect of the following directives:

- 1) The production of a draft execution plan by the Mayor, before the start of the works being considered, accompanied by estimated costs to be submitted to the relevant Divisional Delegate of Public Contracts for endorsement, who shall act within a maximum period of seven (7) days;
- 2) Notification of the date of the effective start of works and of their estimated end, to the Divisional Delegate of Public Contracts by the Mayor, after endorsement of the draft execution plan.
- 3) The acceptance of works executed by a Tenders Board which the Divisional Delegate shall be a member thereof;
- 4) Submitting the expenditure payment outline to the Divisional Delegate of Public Contracts, justifying the statement of account for amounts made available to Mayors, for the execution of the said works, after acceptance and for endorsement.

I attach the greatest value to strict compliance with the above-mentioned provisions
